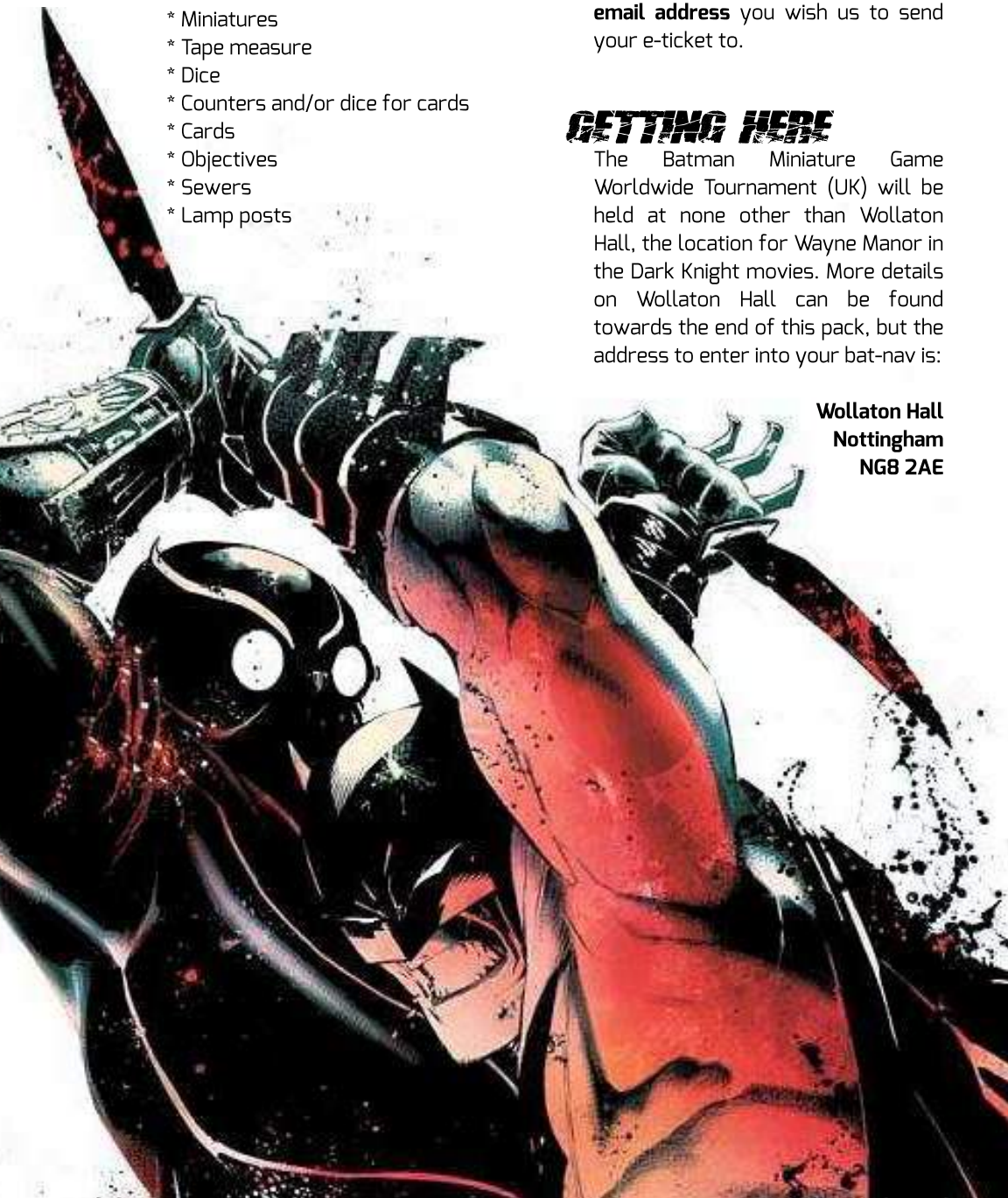

# **TOURNAMENT RULES**



## **BASIC RULES**

The Batman Miniature Game Worldwide tournament will use the latest rulebook (see the Knight Models website for the most up-to-date version), official errata and the official character cards (also available from their website and included in the blister packs for each miniature in the range). Addenda to the rules are included in the tournament pack.

All miniatures used by players to represent their crews must be original miniatures by Knight Models – no alternative models or ‘proxies’ are allowed.

Each game will be played with a single player on each side, on a standard 90x90cm gaming area.

## **CREW LISTS**

In a standard tournament, each player must choose his/her crew from the lists provided in the Batman Miniature Game rulebook, **not exceeding 350 Reputation points and \$1500**. This Crew list must be submitted **by 14th September** to:

## **ROUNDS**

Tournaments progress in a series of tournament rounds, in which each registered player plays a single game.

The tournament will follow the ‘Swiss’ format, in which the participants in the first round will be determined via a random draw. In subsequent rounds, players will be paired based on their total accumulated Tournament Points.

If the number of players in the tournament is odd, the ‘spare’ player – selected at random – will get a ‘bye’ on the first round, and automatically proceed to the second.

## **SCENARIOS**

In each tournament round, all players participate in the same scenario.

**N.B.** In a tournament, players may not select or use the *Global Plan* strategy – Scenarios are always determined by the tournament organiser.



## RESULTS

The Batman Miniatures Game uses a system of Victory Points (VPs) to determine the winner of a scenario. In the Batman Miniatures Game Worldwide Tournament, the difference in Victory Points between the game's winner and loser is used to determine how many Tournament Points a player receives, as follows:

VP difference at the end of the game:

\* **Between 0-5 VP** → Draw / 2 Tournament Points to each player

\* **Between 6-14 VP** → Narrow Victory / 3 Tournament Points to the winner and 1 Tournament





## ***TIE-BREAKERS***

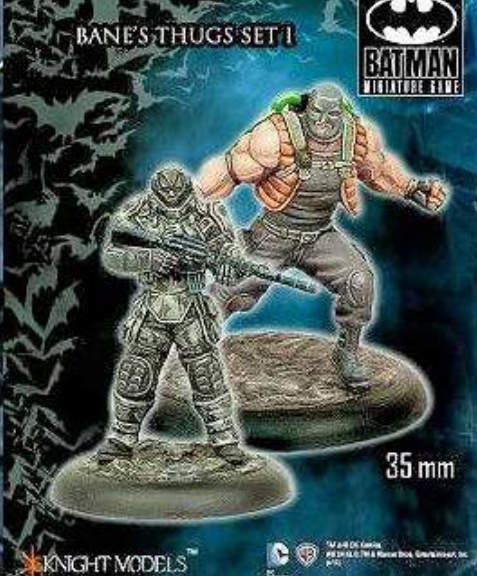
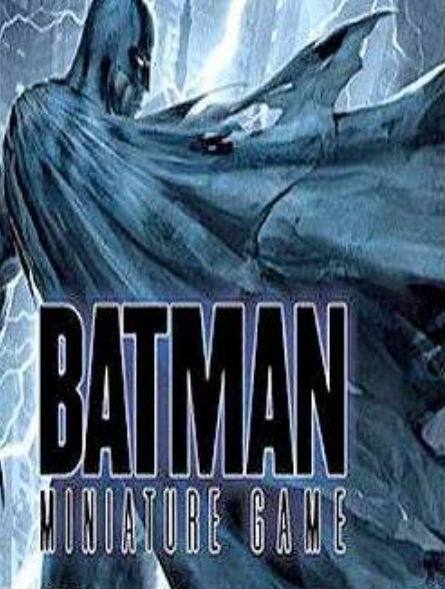
At the end of the tournament, if one or more participants are tied on an equal number of Tournament points, the following steps will be followed - in order - to determine the winner:

1. The player with the highest total number of VPs scored in all rounds is the winner
2. If the tie persists, the player whose Crew has the lowest Reputation is the winner
3. If there is still a tie, the player whose Crew has the lowest dollar (\$ cost is declared the winner

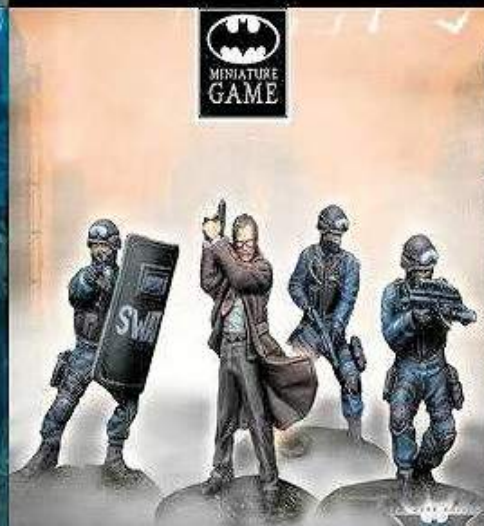
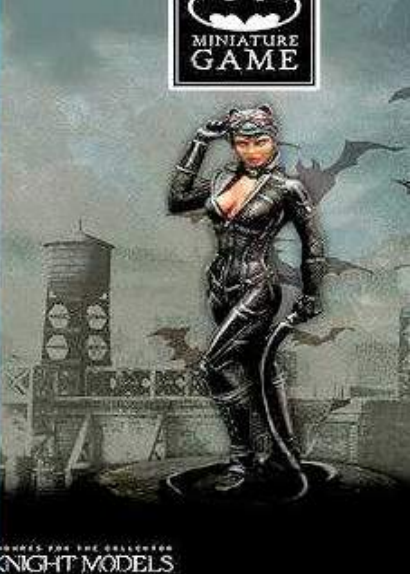
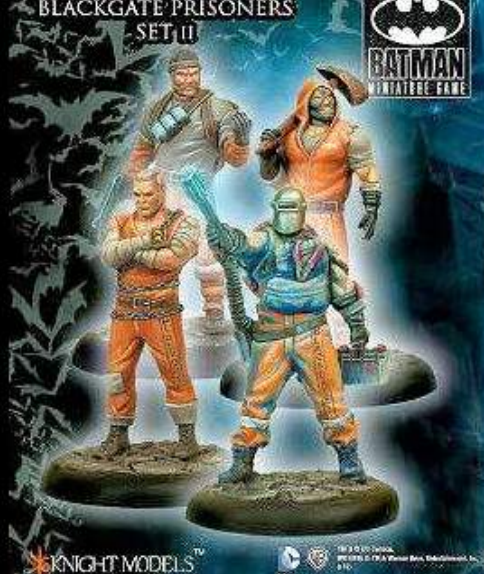
Point to the loser

\* **More than 15 VP** → Victory / 4 Tournament Points to the winner and 0 Tournament Point to the loser

## KR MULTICASE

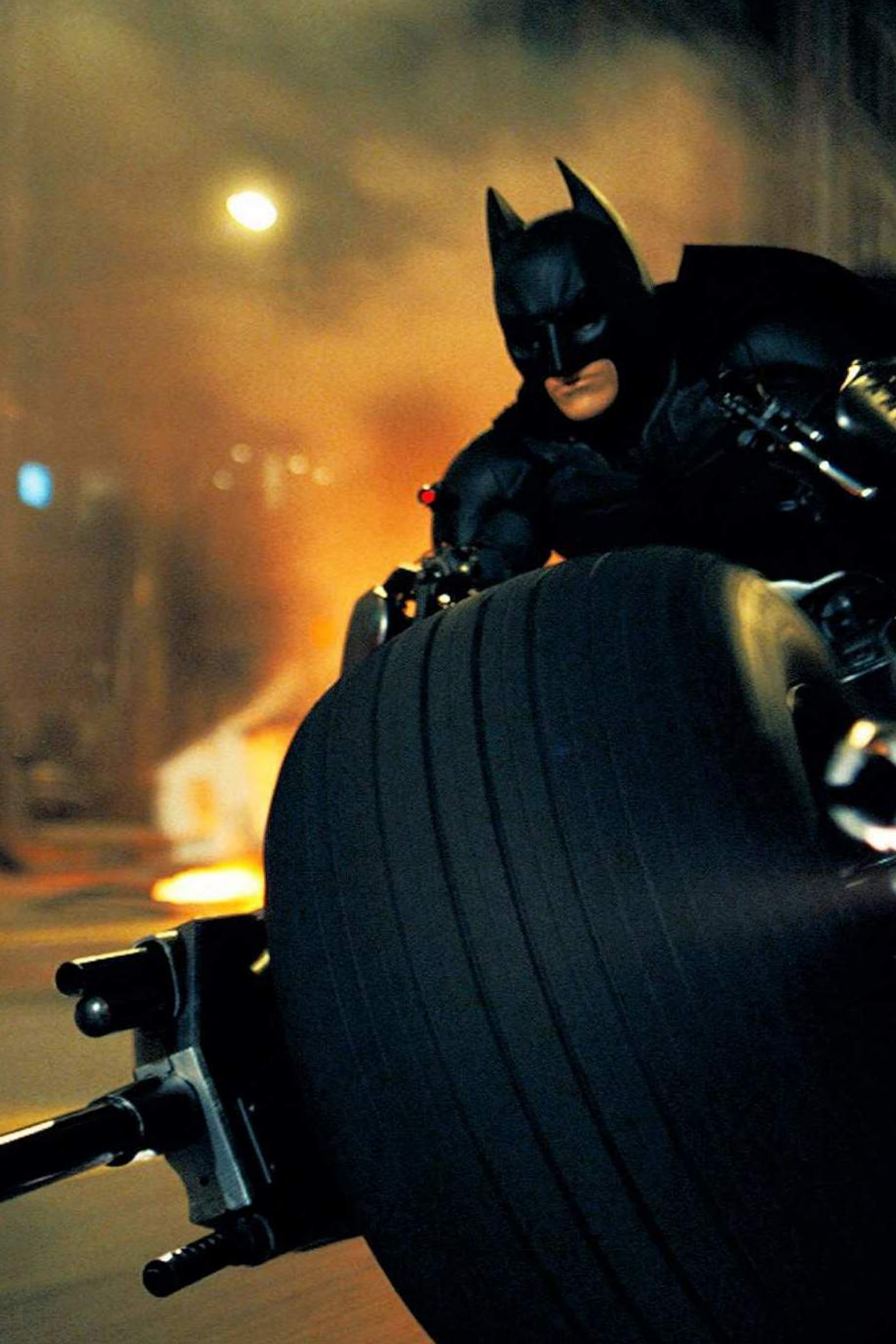

The KR system is based around the philosophy of "soft foam for figures, hard cases for soft foam".

Other transport systems for miniature figures use hard foam and hard tray bases as they use a soft bag system and need the trays to strong enough to stack in tall piles, and additionally require that the trays are always horizontal as the figures need to have space between them and the hard base of the tray above. The hard foam and tray base is not good for figure protection, hence we designed a system where the figures are protected in soft foam.

This soft high tensile foam cares much better for your figures as it does not damage the paint finish, and you can fit a larger figure in a smaller compartment as the foam has enough natural flexibility to deform around the figure and support it. This means that the case can be carried or stored in any orientation (flat, side on, even upside down!) because the tray bases in KR trays are the same foam as the tray itself, so your figures have full protection.

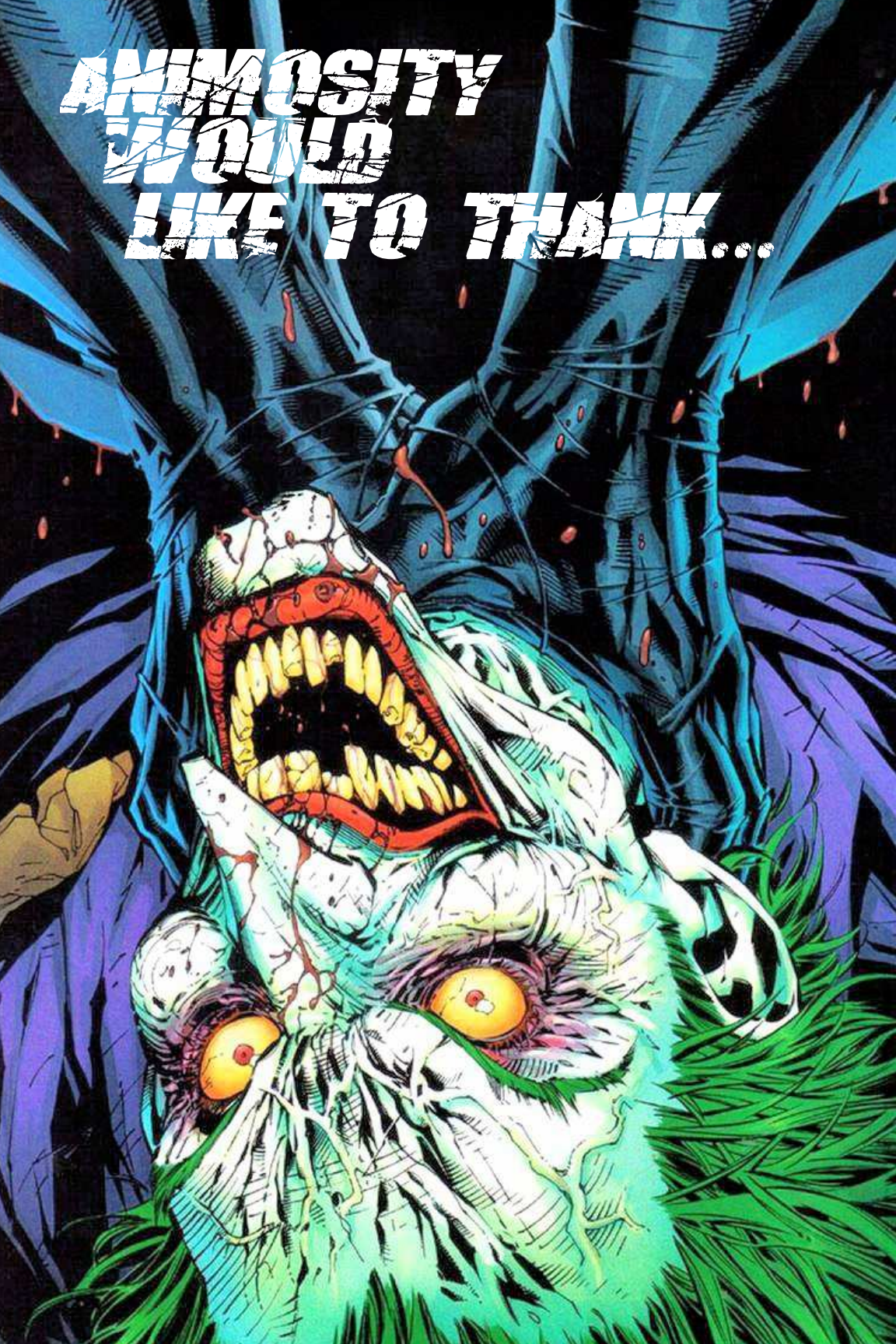
